We are pleased to advise that pursuant to section 271A of the *Mineral Resources Act 1989*, Mining Lease (ML) Numbers 700011, 700012 and 700013 were granted on 21 July 2017.

Area: 438.8 hectares for ML700011; 333.5 hectares for ML700012; 25.79 hectares for ML700013

Note: the Department will, at all times, insist on strict compliance with all terms and conditions of the permits.

What do I need to do now?

- Pro-rata rent is required to be paid. An invoice will be forwarded to you shortly outlining the rental payment details.
- *Notification to Landowners*
 - Notify the owners of the land subject to the MLs within 20 business days.
- A security deposit of **\$1,637.91** is required to be lodged by **18 August 2017** as security to rectify non-compliance as set out section 277(1) of the *Mineral Resources Act 1989*. The security may be in the form of cash or a bond, guarantee or other indemnity acceptable to the Minister provided by a financial institution approved by the Minister.

- **Health and Safety Requirements**
 - You must comply with the requirements of safety and health legislation at all times.
 - You must comply with the requirements of the *Coal Mining Safety and Health Act 1999* and Coal Mining Safety and Health Regulation 2001 for operations on a coal mining permit.
 - Before commencing any operations, notify an inspector of mines for the appropriate region to find out your health and safety obligations and responsibilities.
 - Queensland mining and quarrying operations are required to supply information for all or part of the previous 12 months on the Queensland Mining and Quarrying Industry Census form, located on the Departmental website. The census form for calculating the annual Safety and Health Levy must be lodged quarterly with the department within 20 days of the end of each quarter. - **Cultural Heritage Requirements**
 - Under the provisions of the *Aboriginal Cultural Heritage Act 2003*, a person who carries out an activity under a permit must take all reasonable and practical measures to ensure the activity does not harm Aboriginal cultural heritage (called the ‘cultural heritage duty of care’).  - You are required to pay financial assurance before the commencement of any on ground activities.²
